Auction Wishlist 2009 (Ideas on who to approach)

- Owner of vacation property or time share that could donate one week. (Be sure to get a clear understanding of the restrictions on dates, useage non-smoking rules, cleaning or other fees that the auction donor would need to pay)
- Owner of a private plane, or a corporate plane that could be donated for a round trip – like a New York Shopping Day.
- Someone who offers a service that is interesting or unusual such as– lottery tickets, private lessons (ski, golf, rock-climbing, tennis, swimming), personal chef, personal services (massage), photo studio (family portrait session), private teacher (music lesson, art lessons, personal trainer, dance lessons, etc.), videographer, home organization, pottery painting studio are examples: A builder can showcase a home by offering a private party for 10 – 20 including food, and beverages on a weeknight.
- Everyday items like such as- florist, dry cleaners, home services (carpet cleaners, landscaping, snow plowing), home improvement, optometrists, beauty shops, automotive shop (oil change, detailing, tire rotation)
- Create a basket of themed items – you could solicit these items and group them together or suggest to a local business that they create such a basket. This is especially good for a business like a real-estate or insurance firm that wants visibility but can not give out a product.

Special Items:

- Car dealerships have given wonderful gifts like 1 year lease on a vehicle, autographed sports items, a luxury mountain bike and use of a luxury or sports car convertible for a weekend.
- Hotels and resorts have given weekend packages or week long get-aways.
- Lesson coupons for children or adults, golf foursomes, gourmet meals prepared in the auction winner's own home, a boat cruise with lunch or dinner on the great lakes.
- Group tours, holiday office party for 8-12 at a clubhouse or model home.
- A day on the set of one of the movies shot here in Michigan
- Your local fire or police department may agree to provide lunch at a fire station and ride on a fire truck for a child's birthday, tour of a jail, or day on the bench with a judge.
